



Communities will be provided with information through local Community Health Representatives to remind residents about safe storage of condoms and to be cautious of condoms exposed to extreme cold temperatures in the winter months. Included in this information will be the manufacturer's instructions provided with the condoms which states; "if the latex material is sticky, brittle or obviously damaged, do not use the condom", and/or "if the color of the latex is uneven or changed, do not use the condom," and/or "if the condoms appear changed or defective in any way, please do not use them". It is also recommended condoms be transported on the person (in pants pockets, etc.), rather than storing in a vehicle, purse, jacket pocket, etc., where they can be exposed to extreme cold temperatures.
